

FEE SCHEDULE FOR RELIGIOUS EDUCATION CERTIFICATION CREDIT

Effective August 11, 2009

+For credit *Application for Course Recognition* (form 11.3) is to be turned in to the Certification Team, four weeks prior to the event.
