- avoid responding to vicious texts or emails that might escalate a situation further
- and know when to turn to a trusted adult for help.
- only post the type of information online that you would be comfortable with others seeing

Renowned "bully coach" Joel Haber leads a discussion on how serious and damaging cyberbullying can be, and touches upon recent cases of children committing suicide after being cyberbullied. This timely program will strike a chord with all viewers—those who may have been victimized as well as those who may have thought that cyberbullying was "no big deal."

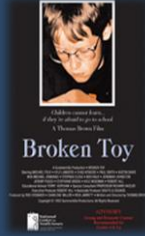
